As we look at what God is doing across the globe, I am incredibly excited to share some wonderful updates from our ministry partners at Global Mission Partners (GMP). I know Elizabeth Church of Christ has a deep heart for the nations, and your faithful prayers and generosity are bearing incredible fruit.

First, we have a massive reason to praise God within our International Church Partnerships. This year, we have witnessed 545 people baptised into Christ and 21 new churches planted in places like Vanuatu, Vietnam and Zimbabwe!

In April, most of our partners around the world gathered in Central Java, Indonesia. This triennial meeting, called "Partner Together for Stronger Communities," provides training on important topics such as leadership, governance, community development, local outreach, and safeguarding. The goal is to help strengthen our partners for a long and fruitful ministry ahead. It was a joy to spend two weeks together, praying, learning and encouraging one another.

This year we officially launched Harvest Partners! This initiative connects Australian Christians with our impactful, frontline local ministries. Harvest Partners will streamline how we support sustainable, locally-led church planting and mission projects, ensuring our resources directly empower local Christian leaders who know their communities best.

Thank you, Elizabeth Church of Christ, for your ongoing partnership in the Gospel. As we celebrate these 545 new believers, 21 new churches, and our expanding work around the world, let's continue to lift up GMP's frontline workers in prayer. God is moving powerfully, and we are privileged to be a part of His global story.

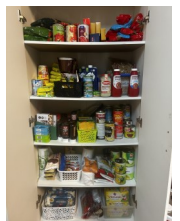
## A Message from the Elizabeth South Community Centre
