
This term at youth we have been looking at reconnecting with our foundations. Going back to some of the most practical elements of our faith; reading scripture, talking to God/hearing his voice, and loving your neighbour. It has been such a blessing to see our youth learn about prayer and hearing God's voice. But by far my favourite night was when we talked about reading the Bible. We talked about how every bible was different and I asked the question "what are some unique features of your bible" and the answers poured in "mine has maps in the back" "mine has an index of words" "mine has a background of each book" "mine has words highlighted and notes on the side" (said by a teenage boy who was reading from my own personal bible ha ha). I was watching these young people get so excited by the different unique features in their personal bibles. And I thought to myself when was the last time I was genuinely excited about the unique features of my own personal faith. We have a God who loves to connect with his children, who is the same and unchanging, but who connects with each one of us on a personal level. Just like how some bibles had maps and others had measurements, exploring how other people see God helps me to understand him better and gain even more insight into our wonderful Father. So my encouragement to you as we move into this time of remembering and celebrating what Jesus did for us over Easter, I invite you to examine your personal faith. Who has God proven himself to be in your life, and chat with a friend about how

they see God as well. And be excited for one another. Because it is SO exciting that we get to constantly discover, learn and love God more and more.

- The freedom in Australia that we have to come together each week to praise God openly as a family of believers.


PRAY FOR:
