## It Just Works

I am no mechanical engineer. I would even say I am not that mechanical at all. But

what I do know is that gears work. Gears come in all shapes and sizes and are used in various mechanisms. I don't know a whole lot else, except I know that if they are connected properly they will transfer the power (from things like an engine) to the moving parts (like the driveshaft of the wheels). They will do their job and it makes the car move.

I am a bit flabbergasted by the working of God's church as well. I don't claim to understand how people from all backgrounds, generations, ethnicities, and viewpoints can join together and transfer the gospel power into the community, but it works. When we are joined together (like the gears) and the power of God is moving, our lives are spun in away that God's glory is moved through us. It is quite remarkable. I know that may be a poor example, but it is vital that we use our giftings and callings to be unified. If those gears are side by side, but not interwoven they will not all spin. If they don't all spin the power is not transferred. Matter of fact, the one that is spinning freely from the others could spin out of control. The mechanical working depends on them spinning together. This is also true of the Body of Christ.

...... <sup>16</sup> From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows, and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work. Ephesians 4:11-13&16 We are gifted, called, and equipped to be like Jesus. It is when the world sees Jesus

in our unified lives that the power of the Gospel connects and does its work. Therefore, we must do our part, we must obey where God has placed us and how he has purposed us. Our unity does matter. When we are unified it just works, I can't explain it, but it works.

#### PRAISE GOD FOR:


- Brent's sermon from Ephesians 4: 1-6 last Sunday encouraging us to make every effort to keep unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.
