The theme for this term at youth has been The Game of Life! We have had so much fun super sizing board games and working out ways to apply the lessons learned in the game, to our own lives. A few weeks into the term I got up the front to explain what we are doing for the night. As I started to go through the game, one of the youth asked us "are you going to apply this to our real lives?" I laughed and said he would have to wait and see, and all through the game he was trying to guess the lesson.

I'm not even sure I remember what the lesson was that night, but I do remember what this young person said. I thought back to the sermon series we have been going through over the past few weeks and I was reminded of this little moment from youth. For this young person, they longed to know what it was we were trying to teach. He wanted to learn, and understand. And because of that he fully immersed himself in the game just so he could figure out what was being taught. And I saw him demonstrating these three Ls.

Looking to Jesus; all he wanted to do was see what I was teaching. If we want to grow we need to look at what Jesus is teaching us. Look at his life and the way he lived, look at the people he surrounded himself with and how he loved. He is the one with the answers, the one who gives us everything we need. We need to look to Jesus as the ultimate example of everything we want to be.

Learning from Jesus; this young person looked for a lesson in the everyday life, in the ordinary. There is so much we can learn from the life of Jesus. But he also gives us his spirit. The Holy Spirit is the counsellor, the one who leads, convicts and comforts us. He is the teacher that is guiding us in our every moment, in the ordinary of our lives. Leaning on Jesus; when we aren't able to figure it all out, when the learning is long and the pruning is tough, he is the one we can lean on. He is the one that is with us in the long run.

I know this is nothing new or profound, but I love this idea that we are all constantly

learning and trying to become more like Jesus. And what if we could walk through life with the same curiosity as this young person, looking, learning and, leaning into all that Jesus is trying to do in our lives.

**URGENT PRAYER
NEED for the Indian
Church**



Pray for the Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Amendment Bill, 2026. India's parliament is considering a law that would allow the government to seize the buildings, equipment, and assets of any organisation that receives foreign donations — including Dignity Freedom Network (one of our Mission partners) - if their international funding license is cancelled or not renewed.

The fear is that licenses will simply be revoked -systematically - and that properties built through decades of faithful partnership will be transferred to government control.

The passing of this Bill could impact hospitals, schools, aged care facilities and more across the country - historically funded by foreign partners.

The Indian church has called for a National Day of Prayer and Fasting on June 28th. Would you join us in prayer?

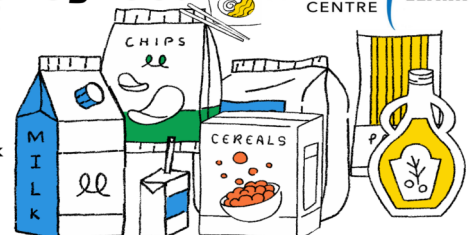
