As we continue to move through the book of Acts, two things stand out straight away. Firstly there is persecution. In chapter four it comes in the form of threats and being dragged before the council. In chapter 5 the persecution intensifies and the first attack comes from within, then comes jail, then more threats and finally beatings and more threats. You would have thought this would have stopped the church in its tracks and slowed down its growth. However, that's not what happened, in fact the reverse happened, the church did not stop growing, if anything its growth increased.

The second thing we notice is the church is more or less Unstoppable. Francis Chan said, "When I read the book of Acts, I see the church as an unstoppable force. The church was powerful and spreading like wildfire. Not because of clever planning, but by a movement of the Spirit. Riots, torture, poverty, or any other type of persecution couldn't stop it. Isn't that the type of church movement we all long to be a part of?"

In Matthew 16:17-19 Jesus said the gates of hell will not be able to overcome the church, and this is what we are seeing in Acts. As Francis Chan said, wouldn't it be amazing to be a part of a church like that! What was its secret, what lay behind such a powerful movement?

In the sermon on Sunday we will look at five reasons why the early church was UNSTOPPABLE and what we can learn for our church today.


