### Walk with Character

Therefore I, a prisoner for serving the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of your calling, for you have been called by God. <sup>2</sup>Always be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other's faults because of your love. <sup>3</sup>Make every effort to keep yourselves united in the Spirit, binding yourselves together with peace. Ephesians 4:1-2

I know I am not worthy. I know that when it comes to living a life for Christ, I fall short daily. Just looking at a few ideas from verse 2 above reminds me that I fail often. I mean I am humble (ha ha), but patience or gentleness may be a struggle at times. I also might not always love others enough to forgive their faults. How about you? Do you think living a worthy life is easy?

How is it that Paul pleads with us to live a life worthy of our calling? He himself knows that doing the right thing is a struggle (read Romans 7:21-24). So, what motivates him to expect worthiness from Christ-Followers?

I would dare say it is a two-fold concept. The Righteousness of Christ and the Power of the Holy Spirit. I have been reading a delightful book on this idea. (The Bookends of the Christian Life)

It is the Righteousness of Christ that Redeems, Restores and Repurposes anyone who will follow Jesus. It is the Righteousness of Christ that covers our sinfulness and makes us blameless and holy in the sight of the Father.

To Walk with a worthy character, we must first embrace the reality of living in the righteousness of Jesus. This will remove the fears, doubts, and struggles we have with our identity. We are seen, through Jesus, as the perfect loved sons and daughters of God. We can't let the enemy shame or confuse us into believing anything else.

The second concept to embrace is the work of the Holy Spirit. It is the Power of the Holy Spirit that transforms us. It is the Power of the Holy Spirit that takes the perfect work of Christ and applies it to our imperfect life. Yes, we are seen as holy and blameless due to the work of Jesus. Now the Holy Spirit starts moulding and shaping us to be more like Jesus.

To walk with a worthy character, we must embrace the reality of the Holy Spirit's work in our lives. Anything we do that is beneficial to the Kingdom is only done when we surrender ourselves to the work of Holy Spirit. Realizing this truth takes away the pressure to perform or measure life by worldly success. Our only goal is obedience to the prompting of the Holy Spirit.

Therefore, we must let him lead our lives. We must be obedient to where he directs us. This mindset will produce fruit for the Glory of God.

Paul's understanding of Righteousness (only in Christ) and power (only Holy Spirit) is why he can encourage us to live a life worthy. We have been set free (work of Christ) and we have been equipped (power of Holy Spirit) to live a life that brings Glory to God. To live a life worthy of our calling. Let's dig into what this Character looks like. See ya Sunday.
