



KID'S MINISTRY PARENT LETTER: Term 2 2026



Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Welcome to Term 2.

It has been wonderful having so many children come to Kid's Ministry during Term 1.

We also enjoyed time together recently at the picnic where several children and their families spent several hours together talking, playing and eating food. A special thank you to Sophie Brill who organized two engaging games for all to enjoy.

CURRICULUM: The curriculum for Term 2 is called **"Eternity and Beyond."**

In this series of 12 lessons, kids will set off on an adventure, taking on the role of space explorers. Along the way, they will learn about the most important mission in the galaxy: following Jesus. The mission is full of adventure and challenges, but it comes with the ultimate reward: those who follow Jesus will spend all eternity with Him in heaven.

GRADE 5 AND 6 JUNIOR YOUTH KIDS.

After meeting with Jadyne who runs the Junior Youth program, she and I have decided to trial Grade 5 and 6 joining the Kid's Ministry program for the first 15 minutes each week. They would be so helpful in leading the song we are learning for the Family Service. They would join in with our songs of praise, learning the memory verse and our time of prayer before either going back into the church for the remainder of the service or continuing to the Youth Shed for the Junior Youth program. This will begin Sunday 3rd May.

KID'S MINISTRY VISIT TO SALISBURY FIRESTATION FRIDAY 8TH MAY 6:30 PM -7:30 PM: An excursion to the Salisbury Fire Station has been planned for Friday 8th May. The children will be given a fire safety talk before being shown a fire engine and being allowed to climb on it. Then we can go across to McDonalds for a soft serve if your child is allowed to stay up a bit later. However, a maximum of 40 can attend including the adults. 20 have already sent in a RSVP. Children must be 4 years and older. Please see me if you would like to come.

MISSIONS GIVING: For the month of April and early May the children will be raising money to support the firemen in the local community who keep them safe. We plan to buy packet mixes to bake cupcakes, biscuits or chocolate brownies to take to the Salisbury Fire station on the 8th May. It would be great if families would bake one packet mix with their child to bring on the night.

Then in May and June we will continue raising funds to purchase two Bibles in the native language of the country we decide to send them to which will enable Pastors to study and spread the word of God within their communities, and to buy 4 fruit trees. Planting indigenous trees preserves the local environment, fosters conservation, and provides nourishing fruit for the community. Our target is \$100. So far this year we have reached \$42. The main point of this is to encourage the children to develop a habit of regular giving to God's work so they can support those less fortunate.

NEW CHILDRENS WORKERS: We are excited to welcome new leaders to our team. Naa Koshie Kidega and Marelle Black have both become Kids Min leaders.

FAMILY SERVICES: At the end of each term, we have a family service which provides opportunities for the whole church to hear from the children and Junior Youth what they have been learning.

The children will come up to the stage and perform a song and say the memory verse they have been learning. I have included the links to the songs we are learning this term. It would be wonderful if you would also use these as part of your family devotional times so the children become more confident.
