As Brent if travelling home from the mission trip at the moment I thought I would take this moment to share a bit about our recent Jobs for Life course and graduation.

At the end of September we celebrated our 4th Jobs for Life Graduation. It was a great evening filled with smiles and a lot of pride from the team as we saw our eight students take to the stage and talk about what the course meant to them. For some it was their first time speaking in public! It was great to see so many of their family members and friends come and support them in their completion of the 16-week-course journey that they have been on.

I love the Jobs for Life course, mainly because it gives people focus for their life. Alongside a mentor, it teaches them to strip everything back and look at what they are good at and what they really want to achieve in life. It gets them to make a game plan for life which sets them on their way to working towards their Job for Life. It is also a great course in that it teaches the students all about their identity in Christ and how, even though we may have had some roadblocks in life, which have stopped us from doing things, there is always a way that we can work around them in the future to move forward

In one session this year students had to write a roadblock that had been holding them back in life, say it out loud to the group and then screw it up and toss it in the bin. Done. That roadblock is no longer going to be a hindrance in their life. But while we were doing this God showed me that although we have roadblocks in our life, and yes we need to move past them and not let them control our future, they can also be a very powerful part of our testimony and maybe even our ministry.

Roadblocks can become a great way for us to connect with people in similar situations. We may be able to use our testimony of moving through them to bless others who are also trying to wade through the same problem. A person who has struggled with anxiety for years may be able to be a voice

of calm and hope for a youth that cannot see the other side of their own crippling anxiety. Just like the role models that we use in the course from the bible that work through their roadblocks to get to their promised land, these students are also on their journey towards finding freedom in a their purpose in life through whatever God has asked them to

We pray that these eight participants, and those that have gone before in past years, continue to seek God for guidance and hope as they walk on their journey. Their mentors will continue with them as they work towards their game plan in life.
